

This permission for increase of seats in the above courses and admission of students will be valid each time the first batch of students admitted against the increased intake appears for the final final examination. The college authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under Section 11 (2) of IMC Act for the increased intake of the first batch admitted against the increased intake appears for final year examinations.

This permission is, however, subject to the condition that the bank guarantee furnished by the college authorities for increase of seats in above Courses (a) is found to be in order by the Medical Council of India.


